LEGAL NOTICES. ORDINANCE NO. 130. An Ordinance Prohibiting the obstruction of Public Streets and Entrances to Public Halls and Buildings.

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person to idly stand or sit in or upon any public street, alley, sidewalk or crosswalk in the City of Bisbee, or to stand or sit in or upon any public street, alley, sidewalk or crosswalk, so in any manner to hinder or obstruct the free passage therein of persons passing along the same or so as in any manner to annoy or molest persons passing along the same or to stand in or at the entrance of any church, hall, theater, or place of public assembly so as in any manner to obstruct such entrance.

SECTION II. It shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct any public street, alley, sidewalk or crosswalk in said City by conducting or addressing any assemblage, meeting or gathering of persons or by making or delivering any public speech, lecture or discourse by conducting or addressing any public debate or discussion in or upon any public street or alley in said city without first having obtained a permit in writing from the Mayor of said City.

SECTION III. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon the conviction thereof, shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period not exceeding twenty-five days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
