ORDINANCE NO. 179. An Ordinance to Prevent the Spread of Hydrophobia in the City of Bisbee.

WHEREAS, many dogs in this city and its environs are afflicted with hydrophobia or rabies, and urgent necessity exists to stamp out said disease and guard against the dangers of its existence or recurrence hereafter...

Section 1. That it is hereby made the duty of all Peace Officers to kill or cause to be killed at once upon sight any dog found running at large in this city...

Section 4. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than three months or by a fine not to exceed two hundred dollars...
