Common Council and Keep true accounts of their proceedings, and have the care, control and custody of the records and books of the City, and keep and render true accounts of the receipts and expenditures of money, in such form and manner as the Council may prescribe. He shall make or cause to be made all publications required by law. He shall cause all official bonds of City officers to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder. He shall, before entering upon the duties of his office, execute to the City of Bisbee such bond as may be required by law, or by order of the Council. He shall perform such other duties as may be required by law.

The City Clerk shall receive a compensation of \$125.00 per month. Section 2. That section 3 of said Ordinance No. 2 shall be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

CITY MARSHALL Section 3. The City Marshall shall be the collector of taxes and of all moneys due the City, and all moneys collected or received by him for the City, shall not later than the day following his receipt of same, be by him turned over to the City Treasurer for deposit. For failure so to do the Common Council may remove him from office. He shall make arrests for violations of all Ordinances, and shall have charge and control of the City Jail. He shall attend the meetings of the Council, and shall take monthly reports of all moneys received by him. He shall have the supervision and direction of any policeman that may be appointed by the Council. He shall do all posting required by law. He shall perform such other duties as may be required of him by law. The Marshal, before entering upon his duties, shall execute to the City of Bisbee a good and sufficient bond in the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars, and such other bond as may be required by law, or an order of the City Council, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties.

The City Marshall shall receive a compensation of one hundred seventy five dollars per month. Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the Common Council, and approved by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO. 155 AN ORDINANCE PLACING THE CAPTAIN OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT IN SUPREME CHARGE AT FIRES, AND ADDING A NEW SECTION TO ORDINANCE NO. 123. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BISBEE:

Section 1. A new section to be known as Section 25-A is hereby enacted to become part of Ordinance No. 123 of the City of Bisbee, being an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance creating and maintaining the Fire Department of the City of Bisbee, Arizona, and Regulating the Duties of Officers and members thereof," which new section is as follows:
