

EXCHANGE AT LOWEST RECORD; PROFESSIONAL IS MOST OF MARKET

Checks on All Continental Centers, as Well as London, Go Down; Market on the Whole Is Very Irregular.

NEW YORK, Aug. 30.—The noteworthy feature of an irregular market was its highly professional character. The most significant and depressing development was the further decline in exchange on London to the lowest on record.

Early declines in the market were with mixed gains and losses. The former predominated. Lackawanna Steel, the foremost in its class, advanced 4 3/4 to a new high of 7 1/2.

MAYTORENA TO STAY IN SONORA AS THE HEAD OF ALL AFFAIRS

Nephew of Governor of Sonora Declares His Uncle Will Be Re-appointed By Villa; Knows Nothing of Coming of Angeles.

Contrary to recent press reports, Governor Jose Maria Maytorena will not retire as governor of Sonora and come to the American side on September 1.

Mr. Maytorena says the governor has just received a telegram from Villa ratifying his reappointment as governor of Sonora upon the expiration of his term of office, which takes place today.

Young Maytorena says his uncle has also been reappointed commander in chief of the forces in Sonora. As to the report that General Felipe Angeles will come to Nogales September 1 to take command of the Villa forces in the state, Governor Maytorena has received no official notice to that effect.

LIGHT SENTENCE FOR SOCIALIST LEADER ENCOURAGES PARTY

Taken to Mean That German Government Has Growing Consideration for the Views of Those Who Agitate.

ZURICH, Switzerland, Aug. 30.—German Socialists are pointing to the trial of Heinrich Huncke, one of their leaders, as an illustration of the growing consideration which the authorities have for the Socialist party.

Although he was convicted and sentenced to nine months' imprisonment, the Socialists point out that the accused leader fared far better than even he himself had expected.

The charge of attempting to induce soldiers to be disobedient and mutinous cannot be maintained in its entirety; the accused can only be convicted of this offense in so far as his propaganda happened to reach soldiers and sailors of the army and navy.

All these methods of public agitation have been declared to be illegal by the proclamations issued in connection with the introduction of martial law at the outbreak of hostilities so that to advocate them constitutes the preparation of a serious crime.
