**FINAL HOUR IN MARKET SEES MUCH STRENGTH ALL ALONG THE LIST**

War Specialties Are the Only Stocks Which Move in Early Period of the Short Session; Some Remarkable Gains.

NEW YORK, Dec. 4.—The sudden accession of strength in the final hour was the marked feature of the short session of the stock exchange. Prior to that period the list showed extreme apathy. Total sales only amounted to 224,000 shares.

The specialties constituted the sole feature of the first hour, some of those issues recording sensational gains while others were reactionary. General Motors made a new maximum of 497 1/2. Coppers were a point or two above yesterday in anticipation of favorable dividend action during the coming week.

The bank statement furnished a distinct surprise as the estimated cash gain was of considerable proportions and being turned into contraction of almost seven million. Railroad re-

turns showed gains of several hundred thousand dollars for October. Bonds were irregular. Total sales were \$2,620,000.






