WOMAN WITH NERVE Prevented Fourteen Desperate Men from Breaking Jail. When "Giant Jack" Faced a Revolver in the Hands of Mrs. Kees He Quietly Submitted to the Inevitable.

"To the bravest woman in the west; to the woman who saved her husband and baby from death, and saved society from the infliction of 14 desperate criminals; to Susan Kees, who prevented by her heroism a general delivery from the Walla Walla jail, December 22, 1901, these tokens are inscribed by admiring friends."

Among the desperate men who were locked in the Walla Walla jail were Arthur Rogers, a San Jose bad man, who has had an interior view of many penitentiaries; Marshall Linn, a highwayman, and "Giant Jack" Andrews, the terror of the Coppelhills.

And with that "Giant Jack," who was a terror to men, capitulated to the "bravest woman in the west," and the Walla Walla jail delivery had failed.
