

COUNTY ROADS.

A System Proposed for Numbering Them.

It is Called the "Ten-Block" System.

Two Numbers Are Given to Each of the Divisions.

An Interview with A. L. Bancroft on the System Proposed for Contra Costa County.

Mr. A. L. Bancroft, of San Francisco, arrived in the city yesterday for a brief visit to Los Angeles.

In an interview with a HERALD reporter yesterday Mr. Bancroft said that for nearly three months the more progressive residents of Contra Costa county had been holding meetings in the several districts to perfect the plan which shall secure a better manner of locating roads and the houses thereon.

Mr. Bancroft has a large young orchard of shipping fruits in Contra Costa county, and he attended the meetings; in fact, he developed the system of numbering which is called the "10 block system."

The system is to divide each mile along the roads into ten equal parts, or imaginary blocks of 528 feet, 176 yards, or 8 chains each, and assign to each block two numbers, one on each side of the road.

When a road goes completely through a town and continues beyond, the county numbers are suspended at the town limits.

"See how it works!" suggested Bancroft. "Here are the fine points, and very strong ones, in favor of this system. In fact, it is the only attempt, so far as known, to systematize this thing. The numbers indicate the distance from the starting-point, which can be figured almost instantly. As there are two numbers to each block, divide the house number by two to find the number of blocks from the commencement of the road.

In the naming of streets Mr. Bancroft said that an effort had been made to make as much difference between them as possible so that there would be no difficulty in placing them. In Contra Costa county there is quite a foreign population, and foreign names are in use in some cases.
