A young people's meeting and the "Round Table," under Dr. Hirst, filled up the time left of the afternoon. In the evening Dr. Gonsaulus gave his lecture on "Cromwell and Washington" to a crowded house.

Notwithstanding his grief and the unsettled state of his mind, owing to the news regarding his father which the telegraph brought on Sunday from Chicago, Dr. Gonsaulus delivered the lecture in his usual powerful and inimitable style.

The program today was interesting, as usual. The devotional meeting at 1 o'clock was led by Rev. Will Shepard, of Carpinteria.

At 9 o'clock Prof. A. H. Hutchinson entertained the children in the Presbyterian church with a few of his rapidly-drawn transformation pictures.

At 1:30 Prof. Blakeslee put his chorus class through a final rehearsal for the concert, which took place in the evening.

At 3 o'clock the tabernacle was filled to hear Dr. J. B. Young give his lecture upon "Abraham Lincoln."

Mrs. Knight gave her lesson on salads at 4 o'clock, and at 5 o'clock the long-deferred lecture by Prof. Hammond held the boards, while the evening was devoted to the grand concert by the Orion Club and the chorus class.
