

THE CATTLE THIEVES.

Mungia Released on Habeas Corpus and Immediately Re-arrested.

The long delayed writ of habeas corpus sued out by Pedro Mungia, held by Justice Savage to answer for grand larceny, came up finally before Judge Cheney yesterday afternoon.

The whole matter hinged upon the words told by the prisoner to Sheriff Aguirre in the presence of Mr. Pallen: "Others are implicated. Thomas Alvirte is one. I expect I am done for and it is better that I should go alone."

He did not say where he expected to go or how what the others were implicated in. That was all the testimony of an incriminating nature adduced at the examination, no connection having been shown between Reyes who has confessed to the stealing of the sixteen head of cattle of the Laguna ranch and the petitioner Mungia.

Judge Cheney did not think that this admission of Mungia, unsupported by anything which tended to show his connection with the crime, could be construed as a probable cause to hold him for trial.

As Mungia stepped out of the courtroom he was rearrested by Deputy Sheriff Cline on a new complaint sworn out on the 18th instant by Joseph Gibert, the manager of the Laguna Rancho Farming company.

The two Anaheim butchers accused of having bought the sixteen head of steers knowing them to have been stolen, were discharged by Justice Freeman of Santa Ana.






