10. A Sheriff for the said County of Los Angeles.
11. A County Clerk for the said County of Los Angeles.
12. An Auditor for the said County of Los Angeles.

14. A Treasurer for the said County of Los Angeles.
15. A Tax Collector for the said County of Los Angeles.
16. A District Attorney for the said County of Los Angeles.
17. A Public Administrator for the said County of Los Angeles.

Assembly. Constitutional Amendment No. 6. (Manner in which an officer of the State may incur a deficiency, and prohibiting Legislature from appropriating money to pay same if otherwise incurred.)
Senate. Constitutional Amendment No. 14. (Manner in which cities containing more than thirty-five hundred inhabitants may frame and adopt charters.)

Educational qualification, requiring every voter to be able to write his name and read English language. Refund the debt.
