CRIMINAL CASES HEARD. D. Williams on Trial Before Judge Gunster on a Terrible Charge.

SCHOONOVER CASES SETTLED. Verdict of Not Guilty Taken and the County Directed to Pay the Costs. Patrick Munley and Thomas Gibbons Found Not Guilty—Jury Wanted to Put Costs on Them, but It Could Not Be Done.

D. Williams was put on trial before Judge Gunster yesterday afternoon in the main court on the Finnish charge of having attempted to ravish 5-year-old Anna Kallala. It is alleged that the crime was committed during the latter part of last April near the child's home in Fell township. The child was put on the stand and told all the disgusting details of the crime. When court adjourned for the day all of the testimony for the defense had not been heard, and therefore the defense that will be advanced is not as yet known.

SCHOONOVER CASES SETTLED. The Schoonover-Scanlon cross suits, which have been on the trial list for the last five terms of court were settled yesterday, the parties agreeing that verdicts of not guilty be taken. The suits are the outgrowth of an affray that took place on Capone avenue, in this city, on Sunday, May 28, 1893.
