

GENERAL NEWS OF INDUSTRIES

The business situation has not improved in any marked way since the Philadelphia Press. As compared with the stagnation and collapse of a few weeks ago it is better, but the point of prosperity has not been approached, and in many cases recent activity is falling off.

From mines, \$480,000,000; from transportation, \$1,153,000,000; from commerce, \$190,000,000; from shipping, \$160,000,000, and from banking \$200,000,000.

The railroads of the United States carry in a year 600,000,000 passengers and transport 800,000,000 tons of freight.

The Chronicle computes the gross earnings of 122 railroads for the month of August at \$42,799,261, an increase of \$377,348 over the corresponding month of 1893.

The southern pig iron market may be gauged by sales at Nashville this far this month equal to total sales during August.

Gross railroad earnings for August, covering returns of 122 roads, having a mileage of 100,000 of main line, aggregate \$42,799,261, against \$42,081,386 in August, 1893, a gain of nine-tenths of 1 per cent.

Exports of wheat, both coasts of the United States and Canada, for six consecutive days ended with Sept. 18 (four included as wheat), continue fairly well maintained, the total equalling 2,780,000 bushels, against 2,677,000 in the second week of September last year, 3,384,000 in the week two years ago, and with 6,974,000 in the week three years ago.
