TROUT FISHERMEN.

A Stroudsburg correspondent says: "The season promises to be excellent, and there are few trout fishermen who are not acquainted with McMichael's, Broadhead's or Cherry creeks. Reports from old-time fishermen who have fished these streams for years are favorable. The streams are in fine condition at present, as last summer and fall they were well up, and trout had a chance to work up into the upper streams. Many of the streams in the vicinity of Swiftwater are leased by the Swiftwater Preserve company, and hence a permit has to be obtained before one can fish in these streams. The Pohoqueline association has all the best territory along McMichael's, but there is still lots of good fishing to be had. From Canaanville the reports are that the streams are never in finer condition, and there seems to be plenty of fish. They were not fished out last season and the outlook for splendid catches is fine."
