FARMER UNDERWOOD'S CAT AND THE EAGLE.

But the big eagle was stone dead, and beneath her feet, shot away to the barn still carrying her bit of meat. The cat had out the eagle's throat and laid open his breast. After his death in midair, however, she had been too clever to relax her hold and this fell to the ground but for a few moments as a parachute to save the descent. Thus was none the worse from her death for life among the clouds.

HOME MADE CROW'S HEADS.

Mr. Billings, of Brookdale, has taken complete charge of a New York military manufacture of crow's heads for twenty-five cents a piece. It cost nothing to get a dead crow. Alive it is an elusive bird, and ammunition is expensive. Billings, however, is an enterprising speculator. He has discovered a scheme by which a maximum number of crow's heads can be got with a minimum of expense. He has set up a chicken incubator in which is placed or laid the eggs of about 100 hen crows that have been trapped and confined, with perhaps a dozen cock crows. Within fifteen days the little creatures are hatched, and a fortnight later they are ready to be headed. It is understood that the head of a crow chick is worth just as much as that of the adult of the same species. At the uniform rate of four for a dollar, dead, they will pay the production. Billings is the only crow hatcher in the world, and he is proud of his achievement.

A QUEER BANK.

Mr. Tevksbury, of Ararat, having \$25 to pay on a mortgage, carried the money in a leather wallet in his hip-pocket for a year. A few days ago he went to Carbondale to make the payment. The wallet also contained his marriage certificate, which he intended having framed. A few days later he mislaid the wallet.
