For a Pacific Cable.

THE CORLISS BILL providing for Hawaii and the Philippines and rejecting the offer of the Commercial Pacific Cable company to build a cable without cost to the government and to allow proceeds to government business has been re-revoted favorably in the house and will probably pass. The sentiment is widespread among congressmen that the government ought to be certain of its control over such a cable; that the political interests are too important to permit the taking of any chances.

Nevertheless the offer of the Commercial Pacific Cable company, which is the Postal Telegraph company under a different name, is a liberal one and it shows that the far-seeing business men who compose that company look forward to a time when the interchange of business between the United States, proper, and the Philippines, China and the other countries bordering on the Pacific ocean will be sufficient to make a cable a profitable investment.

It is contended in behalf of this private enterprise that if it is left alone it will have its lines laid and ready for public use within two years at the latest, while a government cable would cost much more and would not be so likely to be laid expeditiously.
