Capture of the Noted Guerrilla, Harry Gilmor--Defeat of His Band.

Wheeling, Feb. 6.—Governor Boreman has received the following telegram: Cumberland, Feb. 6.—A cavalry scout of General Sheridan's encountered the force of Major Harry Gilmor yesterday, near Moorefield, and whipped it handsomely, capturing upwards of twenty officers and men.

In the Northampton County Court, week before last, Michael Hurley was convicted of burglary, rape, aggravated assault and battery, larceny and resisting arrest. Judge Maynard sentenced him to pay the costs of prosecution, and to undergo an imprisonment in the Eastern Penitentiary for the term of 26 years and 6 months.

The Secretary of War has communicated to the Senate, a list of officers of the Regular Army. The General officers are given in the following order: Lieut.-Gen. Grant; H. W. Halleck, Wm. T. The exchanged Union soldiers who have lately arrived from Richmond represent the sufferings now being endured by our men there as greater even, if possible, than they have been subjected to at any previous time. Out of eighteen officers and three thousand privates thirty-six died in one day, from starvation and exposure.

Robert K. Reid, of the 7th Connecticut Regiment, who has been a prisoner since the 15th of May last, says that while at Andersonville, Georgia, two rebel women coming into the camp one day, one of them expressed a wish to see a Yankee shot, and without hesitation a rebel soldier was directed to gratify the lady, and, raising his piece, the infernal deed was done, at which she expressed her satisfaction in decided terms.

A Savannah belle stepped off the sidewalk the other day to avoid walking under the American flag which hung in front of an officer's headquarters. Gen. Geary, military commandant of the city, immediately gave orders to have her promenaded back and forth under the hated symbol for an hour, as a warning for similar offenders.

We publish elsewhere, in this week's paper, a most graphic picture of the doings in the National House of Representatives, during the passage of the greatest measure that has engaged a deliberative body since the time when the Old Continental Congress passed the immortal Declaration of Independence.

We allude, of course, to the passage of the amendment to the Constitution, forever abolishing slavery within the United States. As there is no doubt but that the amendment will be ratified by every loyal State, and at heart by a large majority of the people both North and South, whether residing within loyal limits or outside of them, we think we may safely say that we are now for the first time a free people.

Slavery has always been a drag, as a millstone, about the nation's neck, and would have been abolished long ago, but that the solution of the problem was not plain to the Statesmen of the land. Long ago the first minds of the country, Washington, Jefferson, Madison, Monroe, the Adams's, Jackson, and hosts of men of like mental calibre labored to bring about the same great end, but the times were not ripe for it. It needed a rebellion, such as is now shaking the government to its center, to open the eyes of the people to the immensity of the evil, and to give that strength and courage to our statesmen which was to be exerted to make us free indeed.

The deed, however, though late, has, thank God, been done at last, and we can now hold up our heads before the world, and exclaim—behold a Government in ours, as perfect as the natural depravity of man will permit it to be. The great, good deed is done; the great first cause of our troubles has been consigned to oblivion, and it but becomes us to unite, as one man, in the whipping of rebellious children into the strict line of their duty to make us a people blessed even beyond the most sanguine expectations of those who fought, bled and died that we should be both happy and free.

The Congress of 1776 and the Congress of 1865 will be remembered and honored so long as "liberty" stands as a word in our vocabulary, and represents a principle which has, from the beginning, and will continue to the end, added fuel to the hopes of the oppressed and downtrodden everywhere. Reader the dogma that "all men are created free and equal," is no longer a pleasing fiction as regards these United States. From this time henceforth it is a fixed fact.

Next week we will endeavor to give the vote on the amendment, in the House, so that our readers may know who are, and who are not the true friends of freedom. The yeas and nays will show that quite a number who have hitherto stood unflinchingly in support of pro-slavery democracy, have made use of this occasion to "come out from among the foul party," and evince their determination to stand by "liberty, the constitution and the laws."

We regret that we cannot announce our own representative Mr. Johnson as being among these.
