

The resolutions were informally passed over. The Oregon Territorial bill was then taken up, and a long, rambling debate ensued, in which Messrs. Wamboldt, Foote, Underwood and Baldwin participated.

Mr. Hale obtained the floor, when the further consideration of the bill was postponed until Monday.

Mr. Dayton submitted the following: Resolved by the Senate, That the Vice President be requested to have the flag of the United States first erected by the American agent upon the palace in the capital of Mexico, and now here presented, deposited for safekeeping in the Department of State of the United States.

After some remarks from Mr. Dayton, Mr. Dix, and Mr. Allen, the resolution was adopted.

On motion by Mr. Hannegan, the Senate proceeded to the consideration of Executive business; and, after a brief session therein, the Senate adjourned.

In the House, Mr. Morehead presented the memorial of certain officers of the army in Mexico, in relation to the suitable interment of the remains of the fallen in battle; which was referred to the Committee on Military Affairs.

The private calendar was then opened in Committee of the Whole House; but the committee rose without action.

The consideration of the naval appropriation bill was then resumed in Committee of the Whole on the state of the Union, (Mr. Rockwell in the chair.)

Mr. Pelet at last obtained the floor, when the committee rose, reported no conclusion, and the House adjourned till Monday.

Monday, June 5. There was not anything of importance done in either House to-day.

The Philadelphia Federal Convention, which meets this week for the purpose of nominating the Federal candidates, will take off a large number of both Houses. The Senate adjourned to meet on Tuesday, and the House adjourned on Tuesday to meet on Friday next.

The Discussion in Raleigh.—On Monday last the candidates for Governor—Messrs Reid and Manly—met in this City, according to previous appointment.

Beyond all question Mr. Manly, with all his accessories and good humor, was utterly overwhelmed by the facts and arguments advanced by Col. Reid.

Mr. Reid's speech was fair, liberal, dignified, and argumentative, and it presented a mass of facts which no Whig could have answered, but which he was so much too much too nervous to display on any occasion so which characterized Mr. Manly's speech on Monday last; but we have no room for comments to-day.

We are glad to have it in our power to state that Col. Reid's health has considerably improved, and we indulge the hope that he will be able to resume his usual and vigorous life until the August election.
