BY AUTHORITY.

Acts and Resolutions passed at the First Session of the Thirtieth Congress.

[Public—No. 99.]—An Act to establish the Territorial Government of Oregon.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That from and after the passage of this act, all that part of the Territory of the United States which lies west of the summit of the Rocky mountains, north of the forty-second degree of north latitude, known as the Territory of Oregon, shall be organized into and constitute a temporary government by the name of the Territory of Oregon.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That the executive power and authority in and over said Territory of Oregon shall be vested in a governor, who shall hold his office for four years, and until his successor shall be appointed and qualified, unless sooner removed by the President of the United States.

Sec. 3. And be it further enacted, That there shall be a secretary of said Territory, who shall reside therein and hold his office for five years, unless sooner removed by the President of the United States.

Sec. 4. And be it further enacted, That the legislative power and authority of said Territory shall be vested in a legislative assembly. The legislative assembly shall consist of a council and house of representatives.

Sec. 5. And be it further enacted, That every white male inhabitant above the age of twenty-one years, who shall have been five years a citizen of the United States, and who shall possess the qualifications of an elector, shall be entitled to vote at any election, and shall be eligible to any office within said Territory.

Sec. 6. And be it further enacted, That the legislative assembly shall be organized into a council and house of representatives, and shall hold its first session on the first day of January next following the date of the organization of said Territory.

Sec. 7. And be it further enacted, That the judicial power of said Territory shall be vested in a supreme court, district courts, probate courts, and in justices of the peace.

Sec. 10. And be it further enacted, That there shall be appointed an attorney for said Territory, who shall continue in office for four years, and until his successor shall be appointed and qualified, unless sooner removed by the President.

Sec. 11. And be it further enacted, That the governor, secretary, chief justice, and associate justices, attorney and marshal, shall be nominated, and by and with the consent of the Senate, appointed by the President of the United States.

Sec. 12. And be it further enacted, That the rivers and streams of water in said Territory of Oregon in which salmon are found, or to which they resort, shall not be obstructed by dams or otherwise, unless such dams or obstructions are so constructed as to allow salmon to pass freely up and down such rivers and streams.

Sec. 13. And be it further enacted, That the sum of ten thousand dollars be, and is hereby appropriated, to be paid in advance to the collector of said district, to be used in the purchase of land for the establishment of a collection district.

Sec. 14. And be it further enacted, That the inhabitants of said Territory shall be entitled to enjoy all and singular the rights, privileges, and immunities granted or secured to the people of the Territory of the United States, and to the people of the State of Ohio, by the articles of compact contained in the ordinance for the government of said Territory.

Sec. 15. And be it further enacted, That the legislative assembly of the Territory of Oregon shall hold its first session at such time and place in said Territory as the governor thereof shall appoint and direct; and at said first session, or as soon thereafter as they shall deem expedient, the legislative assembly shall proceed to locate and establish the seat of government for said Territory at such place as they may deem eligible.

Sec. 16. And be it further enacted, That a delegate to the House of Representatives of the United States, to serve for the term of two years, who shall be a citizen of the United States, may be elected by the voters qualified to elect members of the legislative assembly.

Sec. 17. And be it further enacted, That all suits, process and proceedings, civil and criminal, at law and in chancery, and all indictments and informations, which shall be pending and undetermined in the courts established by authority of the provisional government of Oregon, within the limits of said Territory, when this act shall take effect, shall be transferred to the courts established by this act.

And be it further enacted, That all justices of the peace, constables, sheriffs, and all other judicial and ministerial officers, who shall be in office within the limits of said Territory when this act shall take effect, shall be, and they are hereby, authorized and required to continue to exercise and perform the duties of their respective offices, until their offices shall be abolished.
