THE CANVASS FOR GOVERNOR.

We learn that the candidates spoke last week at Jacksonville, Onslow County, in accordance with appointment. A friend writing from Onslow says that Mr. McRae made quite an impression among the Know Nothings...

At Wilson Judge Ellis made a brilliant and effective effort, occupying the two hours assigned him. Mr. McRae was laboring under fatigue and indisposition, and closed after having spoken little over an hour.

The Democratic Convention for this county met here yesterday, and nominated Hon. W. S. ASHE, for the Senate, and GEORGE J. MOORE and R. K. BRYAN, Esqs., for the House of Commons.

The convention was very largely attended, and was harmonious throughout, with a determination to avoid anything that might tend to division. No disturbing questions were brought in.

We are pleased to see this feeling prevailing, as we should be pained by the exhibition of any different one. The distribution of the delegation is in accordance with the custom of the party, which assigns one of the three to the town, and the other two to the country.

We may be permitted here to refer to a matter personal to ourself, and we do so because we would be wanting to our own feelings did we fail to return our acknowledgments to the delegation from the town of Wilmington, who, spontaneously, did us the honor to present our name as a candidate for the House of Commons.

The nominations, as made, meet our most hearty approval, as they will do that of all the Democrats of the county. The correspondence between the Committee of the Convention and George J. Moore, Esq., one of the nominees for the House of Commons is published in to-day's paper.

Congress adjourned on Monday last at six o'clock, p. m., having extended the session a few hours to allow business to be satisfactorily closed up. The main matter done on Monday, was that the Senate receded from all its amendments to the post office appropriation bill.

The Schuylkill at Philadelphia got to sweeping away property and sometimes persons. Cairo, Illinois, the Southern terminus of the Illinois Central Railroad, was in danger of being wholly carried off at the latest dates, and the water stood four feet and a-half deep at the depot.

Cairo is at the confluence of the Ohio and Mississippi rivers, and is the delightful amphibious place immortalized by Dickens in "Martin Chuzzlewit" under the name of Eden. There is a place near Cairo called Mound City, because a few feet of it are generally left dry at high water.

It is said that General Johnson, the Commander of the Utah expedition has no confidence in the professions or intentions of Brigham Young and the Mormons, who he says have only been seeking to over-reach Governor Cummings while they are really arming and fortifying at every point.

"The Great Atlantic Trunk Line Association"

Is the name of a company or association of companies, which, we learn, has just been formed, for the purpose of carrying the great mails, passengers, and express freight and specie between New York, New Orleans and California, including a branch to Havana.

The Rail Road companies between New York and Cedar Keys, Fla., have formed themselves under the name and title above stated, with a general agency and control, and have proposed to the Post Office Department to guarantee the delivery of the mails in New Orleans from New York and in New York from New Orleans in four days, and when some links are completed, in still less time.

No doubt, a large express freighting business will be done by this line, which will be opened for business by the first day of November next. As already stated, a connection will be made with the points of crossing the isthmus from the Atlantic to the Pacific, and the California mails, passengers and express freight, will be forwarded from and delivered at Cedar Keys twice a month, or oftener, from Aspinwall or Tehuantepec, as the case may be.

We give the above facts as we understand them to exist, without any attempt at embellishment or coloring. We might draw a more glowing picture, but we think that the simple facts are sufficient, especially as they will bear the most rigid scrutiny.

We have a word to add about our line from this point to the Chesapeake Bay. It is said that a branch from Enfield on the Wilmington and Weldon Road to Suffolk, in Virginia, on the Seaboard Road, will probably be pressed on the attention of our Legislature at its next session, and with every prospect of success.

No doubt the mails and a large travel would continue to go via Petersburg, Richmond and Washington City, but certainly a line to the Chesapeake, worked or controlled by the W. & W. R. R. Company, could not fail to be of vast benefit to that road, and to the railroad interest of the State, placing it in a more independent position in regard to its connections, and adding largely to its freighting and express business.

The opening of this proposed branch, however, would, as a matter of necessity, tend to depreciate the value of the stock on the Seaboard Road and it is certainly not the interest, and should not be the desire, of Southern roads to cut each others' throats.
