We noticed a few days since, in the Raleigh "Daily Press," a correspondence between Gov. Ellis and Daniel G. If Mr. W. is opposed to the election of Gov. Ellis, or disapproves of the platform adopted by the party in its late Convention, he might as well go out of the party at once, and join the opposition. An open enemy is always to be preferred to a secret foe.

STEAM COMMUNICATION TO NEW YORK.—By reference to our advertising columns, it will be seen that a contract has been effected by the Cape Fear and Ocean Steamship Navigation Company for the building of one of the iron steamers to ply between Wilmington and New York. Until this steamer is finished, a propeller will run regularly between the two ports twice a month, or oftener if the business requires it. Merchants in the interior will find that their goods will be received with greater dispatch than heretofore, and we believe quicker than by any other route. This is a matter of no little interest to the tradesman.

The Wheat-growers in the interior will find this route cheap, safe and expeditious for the export of their crops to the New York market. The Naval Store maker or dealer will also have an opportunity of placing the article on the market in New York in a much less time than they have heretofore been enabled to do. In fact, the general transportation business will receive a new impetus, and all will come in for a share of the benefits to be derived from this new enterprise. The line must prove a success.

TARBORO' BRANCH RAILROAD.—We learn that track laying was commenced on the Tarboro' Branch of the Wilmington & Weldon Railroad two weeks since, and is now progressing very rapidly, at the rate of 3/4 to 1 1/2 of a mile per day. At this rate the whole track will be laid within 72 days, or by the fourth of next July, as contemplated, when there is to be one big spree at Tarboro'.

We are pleased to see friend Whitaker has met with success in establishing a daily at the seat of Government. One was much needed, particularly once every two years, during the session of the Legislature.

THE DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL CONVENTION. [SECOND DAY.] It would be impossible for us to copy into our columns the lengthy reports of the proceedings contained in the Charleston papers. There appears to be nothing in them which would be of material interest to our readers beyond what we have already laid before them—received by telegraph.

THE PRESIDENT'S SPEECH. Mr. Cushing on taking the Chair as permanent President of the Convention, proceeded to address the delegates as follows: Gentlemen: The Convention: I respectfully tender you my most earnest expression of my profound gratitude for the honor which you have this day done me in appointing me to preside over your deliberations. It is, however, a responsible duty imposed, much more than a high honor conferred. In the discharge of that duty, in the direction of business and of debate, or the preservation of order, it shall be my constant endeavor faithfully and impartially to officiate here as your minister, and most humbly to reflect your will.

In a great deliberative assembly like this it is not the presiding officer in whom the strength resides; it is not his strength, but yours—your intelligence, your sense of order, your instinct of self-respect. I rely, gentlemen, confidently upon you, not upon myself, for the prompt and parliamentary dispatch of the business of this convention.

Gentlemen: You have come here from the green hills of the Eastern States, from the rich States of the imperial center, from the sunlit plains of the South, from the fertile States of the West, from the States of the Pacific, from the golden shores of the distant Oregon and California. [Loud cheer.] You have come hither in the exercise of the highest functions of a free people to participate and to aid in the election of a future ruler of the Republic.

You do this as the representatives of the democracy of the Union, whose proud mission it is to maintain the public liberties, to recognize popular freedom with constituted order—to maintain the sacred, reserved rights of the sovereign States. [Loud and long continued applause.] To stand, in a word, the perpetual sentinel of the outposts of the constitution. [Cries of "That's the motto," and loud cheers.] "That's the motto," is the motto inscribed on that scroll, or that banner, which is the motto of the great Statesman of South Carolina—"Truth, Justice and the Constitution." [Loud cheer.] Opposed to us are those who labor to overthrow the constitution, under the false and insidious pretense of supporting it. Those who are aiming to strike down this country a permanent sectional conspiracy of one-half of the Union against the other half; those who, impelled by the stupid and half insane spirit of faction and fanaticism, would hurry our land on to revolution and to civil war.

These, who are the banded enemies of the constitution, it is the part of the democratic party of the Union to withstand—to strike down and conquer. Aye, that is our part! And we will do it, in the name of our dear country—with the help of God we will do it. [Loud cheer.] Aye, we will do it; for, gentlemen, we will not distrust ourselves—we will not despair of the genius of our country—we will continue to press on with unshaken faith in the good providence of Almighty God. [Loud applause.]

Mr. Cushing having concluded his remarks, the vice-presidents and secretaries came forward, and about half an hour was consumed in seating them upon the platform and preparing for a formal and energetic enforcement of parliamentary rules in the future proceedings of the convention. After a short recess, the convention, at 12 o'clock, was called to order again. Mr. Jackson, of Georgia, rose to a question of privilege, relative to his State delegation. A motion to adjourn till 4 o'clock was lost. The question was then called on the motion to strike out the rule relative to the right of the members of each delegation to vote as they think proper, unless instructed by the convention, and the question was put. The question was put on the rule as it stood, and the affirmative was carried by a large majority. During the calling of the roll in taking the vote, great excitement prevailed, and the Tennessee, Indiana and Virginia delegations protested against the announcement of the chairman of the delegations giving the vote of the several States as a unit against the adoption of the rule. Two of the twelve Tennessee delegates were opposed to the manner in which that State had been recorded. The vote was finally announced—yes 101, says 198. So the rule was adopted, and a majority of a delegation cannot compel the minority to vote with them as a unit, unless instructed by the convention that appointed them. The resolution offered yesterday for the appointment of a committee on resolutions, and to prepare a platform, was called up, and an amendment was offered that no balloting be allowed for presidential nominees until the committee has reported. The vote was taken first on the proposition for the appointment of the committee, and it was adopted, and the committee was at once appointed. [The vote on the rule against unit voting is regarded as a test vote.] The vote lay on the table was:—Ayes—Massachusetts 6; Pennsylvania 14; Delaware 13; Maryland 3 1/2; Virginia 10; North Carolina 7; South Carolina 8; Georgia 10; Texas 4; Alabama 9; Louisiana 6; Mississippi 7; Florida 4; Arkansas 2; Missouri 2; Ohio 2; Oregon 3—total 101. Nays—All the balance of the votes of the States—total 198. The rule was then adopted by acclamation. After the committee on the platform was announced a motion was made that no balloting should take place until the report of the committee on the platform should be made. The motion lay on this resolution on the table was rejected—ayes 32 1/2, says 270 1/2. The vote was then taken on the resolution and it was adopted by acclamation. A long debate then ensued on the proposition to limit members from speaking more than once on the same subject. The president was directed to invite ministers of the Gospel to open the convention with prayer. Judge Meek submitted the Alabama platform, which was referred to the committee on the platform. The committee on credentials announced that they would not be able to report before to-morrow morning. The convention then adjourned till 10 o'clock to-morrow (Wednesday) morning. [THIRD DAY.] [Our telegraphic reports yesterday furnished our readers with the result of the third day's proceedings of the Convention. Below we give extracts from the papers received this morning as we deem requisite to a more full understanding of the progress of the Convention.] On meeting in the morning, the gallery of the Hall was crowded with ladies, and it being filled, on motion, several hundred who were crowding outside, unable to enter the gallery, were admitted to the floor of the convention, occasioning much good feeling. The resolution submitted yesterday, restricting speakers to fifteen minutes, and to speak but once on the same subject, was taken up, and after some debate, was rejected—ayes 170, says 121. A resolution relative to debate was then introduced, restricting speakers to fifteen minutes on all subjects except the platform. A Southern delegate demanded that there should be no gag law on any subject. The resolution was finally adopted. The committee on credentials announced that they would be ready to report this afternoon. Adjourned until 4 o'clock. The following States voted for the admission of the Wood delegates, in committee, viz: Mississippi, Alabama, Texas, North Carolina, Georgia and California. The committee on platform rejected the Cincinnati platform by a vote of 17 to 15—the Southern members demanding one that will not be liable to different constructions. At four o'clock the Convention reassembled. A resolution to appoint a national committee to act for the next four years was discussed, and finally referred to a select committee to inquire into the propriety of giving the national committee power to name both the time and place of holding the convention. The committee on Credentials made their report—[The result of which appeared yesterday.] A minority report was presented, signed by members of the committee from Alabama, California, Arkansas, Texas, Georgia and Mississippi, recommending that one-half of each of the New York constituents be admitted to the convention, each to cast seven votes. Rejected. The only States that voted in the affirmative were North Carolina, 5; Georgia, 10; Virginia, 3 1/2; Missouri, 1; Alabama, 9; Mississippi, 7; Texas, 4; Tennessee, 9; California, 3 1/2; Arkansas, 3. Total, aye, 55; nays, 210 1/2. So the Dean Richmond delegates were admitted and the Wood delegates were excluded. A resolution admitting the Wood delegates to honorable seats, was laid on the table until to-morrow. Mr. Montgomery moved that the resolution for appointing a national committee be laid over till after the nomination of the candidates for the Presidency and Vice Presidency. The death of ex-Gov. Robinson, of Vermont, was then officially announced to the convention, and resolutions of condolence and resolving to accompany the remains of the deceased from the Mills House to the boat immediately after the adjournment of the convention, were adopted. The convention then, at 7 o'clock, adjourned. THE PLATFORM. The following is the additional planks of the platform adopted in Committee on Friday last and reported to the Convention: Mr. Avery of North Carolina, presented the following from a majority of the Committee on Resolutions: MAJORITY REPORT. Resolved, That the Platform adopted at Cincinnati be affirmed, with the following resolutions: 1. Resolved, That the Democracy of the United States hold these cardinal principles on the subject of slavery in the Territories: First, That Congress has no power to prohibit slavery in any Territory, whether at home or in any foreign land, to the same extent as its native-born citizens; 2. Resolved, That the enactments of State Legislatures to prohibit slavery in their Territories, are in violation of the Constitution, and revolutionary in their effect. 3. Resolved, That it is the duty of the Federal Government to protect, when necessary, the rights of persons and property on the high seas, in the Territories, or wherever they may be. 4. Resolved, That the Democracy of the Nation recognize as the imperative duty of this Government to protect the rights of the people in their rights, whether at home or in any foreign land, to the same extent as its native-born citizens; 5. Resolved, That the National Democracy earnestly re-assert the principle of the non-interference of the United States with the acquisition of the Island of Cuba, at the earliest practicable period. Whereas, that one of the greatest necessities of the age, in a political, commercial, postal and military point of view, is a speedy communication between the Pacific and Atlantic coasts. Therefore, be it 6. Resolved, That the National Democracy party do hereby pledge themselves to use every means in their power to secure the passage of some bill for the construction of a Pacific Railroad, from the Western line of the Mississippi River to the Pacific Ocean, at the earliest practicable moment.
