Hayward, of Wake, have all been mentioned in connection with the vacancy for Congress from the Fourth District.

EASTERN DIVISION OF THE WESTERN NORTH CAROLINA RAILROAD.—We learn from the *Wilmington Citizen*, that the annual meeting of the Stockholders of the Eastern Division of the Western North Carolina Railroad Company, was held at Morganton on Thursday last. Messrs. S. McD. Tate, A. Merrimon, Z. B. Vance, and John C. Caldwell, were elected Directors on the part of the private Stockholders for the current year. The Governor and Council appointed J. L. Henry, J. J. Mott, J. W. Bowman, W. G. Candler, Mr. Howerton, C. J. Cowles, Tod R. Caldwell and C. L. E. Corpening, Directors on the part of the State.

It was resolved to complete the road to Malon's Store, 3 miles from the top of the Blue Ridge and 21 miles from Asheville, at once.

The estimates of work done as far as Asheville is to be made at once, with view to a settlement with the Stockholders at an early day. It will be determined about a month hence, whether the work will go on or close.

NAVIGATION COMPANY.—Some days ago the agents and officers of this Company required tolls from the boats navigating the river from here to Wilmington. We learn the manager or captain of the North State, a boat run and owned by the Enterprise Line, in no way a stockholder in the Navigation Co., submitted his freight list, but protested payment, denying the right to exact tolls. On last Monday therefore, no tolls being tendered, the officers of the Navigation Company acting by amendment to the charter in 1852, and by the terms of the charter in 1852, and by attachment of the steamer North State for the tolls of the previous trip, in amount some \$13.—A replevin bond for some \$27, double the tolls, was at once given and the boat was not delayed. It seems, though, that this former seizure or attachment will or can be made every trip here and at Wilming-

ton, and require each time a small replevin bond. This proceeding is in the nature of attachment and this power is conferred by amended act of the Legislature of 1852.

The original charter of Roanoke and Cape Fear Navigation Companies passed in 1797 we believe. We hear that more summary proceedings than this process of attachment are to be at once adopted. It would be better to get up a case by consent, involving the whole issue, and enter it at our next court, and from there to Supreme Court, and thus test the issues.
