RANCID BUTTER.—We can exchange the following recipe!—To a pint of water add thirty drops (about half a teaspoonful) of liquor of chloride of lime.

Wash in this two and a half pints of rancid butter, when every particle of butter has come in contact with the water, let it stand an hour or two; then wash the butter well again in pure water.

The butter is then left without any odor, and has the sweetness of fresh butter. These preparations of lime have nothing injurious in them.

NOTE.—We have heard of rancid butter being placed on the table without any of the trouble referred to; but we do not recommend any one to try it.
