DISTRICT BILLS TO BE BROUGHT UP IN HOUSE

Union Station Measure Among Others Likely to Come Up for Consideration.

According to agreement tomorrow will be "District day" in the House of Representatives, and will be devoted to the consideration of legislation pertaining to Washington and the territory included within the District of Columbia.

A number of bills are on the calendar, the most important being that providing for the creation of a union station. It is probable that nearly the entire day will be spent in the discussion of this measure.

Chairman Babcock of the District Committee, will probably lead in any debate that may arise. Besides the members of the committee, he will probably be supported by Judge Jenkins, chairman of the House Judiciary Committee.

Whether the other District bills will be brought up before the union station bill in an endeavor to get them out of the way, or whether they will be considered afterward, remains entirely with Chairman Babcock.
