QUESTION OF CONTEMPT

The authority of a judge presiding in a United States district court, to punish for contempt a person who assaults an officer of the court, has been submitted to the Supreme Court by the United States for decision. The question comes up from the Northern district of Florida, and is the result of an attack made by W. C. O'Neal, president of a bank at Pensacola, on A. Greenhut, a trustee in bankruptcy. In the altercation Greenhut was out with a knife and the presiding judge in the Northern district of Florida sentenced O'Neal to sixty days' imprisonment in jail. From this judgment he took an appeal.

ATTORNEY BELL URGES AN EARLY DECISION

Submits a Written Statement to Commissioners in Regard to the Lawrence Site.

Alexander H. Bell, attorney for Albert Carry and Robert Porter, who propose to erect a building on the site of the Lawrence Hotel, has submitted a written statement to the District Commissioners relative to the line of E Street.

"The north line of E Street runs all the way from Thirteenth to Fourteenth Street, and forms the southern boundary of the square in which the Hotel Lawrence lot is situated; that the southern line of E Street is south of Pennsylvania Avenue, and runs all the way from Thirteenth to Fourteenth Street, and forms the northern boundary of the square in which the Southern Railway offices are located, and that the existence of the reservation which partly confronts our property is not shown on the King plats except as a part of the roadway."
