ORCHESTRA AND CHOIR UNITE IN A CONCERT

Symphony Players and Singers of Carroll Institute Delight Large Audience With Their Excellent Work.

A joint concert by the Washington Symphony Orchestra and Carroll Institute Choir served to draw a large audience to the Columbia Theater last night when Rossini's "Stabat Mater," with orchestral accompaniment, and a symphony program by the orchestra under Mr. DeKoven's direction formed the evening's entertainment. The reputation of the local orchestra did much to attract the large audience, but after the performance of the Rossini work by the choir, the latter organization will undoubtedly do much toward filling the house upon its next appearance.

The first half of the program was devoted to the orchestral numbers which included the overture to "Euryanthe," a number that scored a distinct artistic success at the symphony concert last Friday afternoon; "The Adagio," from Saint Saens' Second Symphony; the "Peer Gynt Suite," of Grieg; DeKoven's "Flower Ballet," and several other compositions. In all its numbers the orchestra proved the impression made last Friday, and verified the prediction that it would take its place among first-class symphony organizations of the country. Under Mr. DeKoven's leadership its work was admirable, and the applause was enthusiastic and sincere.

In the past few months much has been said and written about the Carroll Institute Choir, but it remained for them last night to demonstrate what fine material it is made of. In the familiar numbers of the "Stabat Mater," chorus and soloists sang with fervor, precision, and the exactness of experienced singers. Mrs. Clara Baker Smith, musical director of the choir, has rehearsed the singers continually. Since the work was conducted by Mrs. Smith and the choir in preparation for the concert last night was manifest in every note of the "Stabat Mater." The soloists were Mrs. Annie Grant Fugitt, soprano; Mrs. Margaret Nolan Martin, contralto; William D. McFarland, tenor; and Arthur W. Porter, basso. Each was accorded generous applause for their respective work. The choir is composed of about eighty-five members, most of whom are choir singers of Washington.

The entertainment last night began a series of "pop" concerts, a form of amusement that has never previously been carried to success here. It will be continued throughout the winter.
