

Stock Market Dull and Irregular, With Prices Inclined to Recede

COPPER AND SUGAR SHOWED STRENGTH

Operations Still Pursuing a Waiting Policy.

STEEL STOCKS WEAKER

Common Breaks to New Low Record. Changes in Quotations Mostly Confined to Tractions.

NEW YORK, May 11.—The stock market opened irregularly, with activity confined to a few issues. Consolidated Gas declined 1/4 under small offerings, but rallied slightly. Copper gained 1/2. New York Central lost 1/4 on 300 shares. Steel preferred and sugar lost 1/4.

The stock market continued dull today, but the early tendency was downward. The only new influence was the Government crop report, showing an extremely poor start for winter wheat. Declines, as a rule, were confined to small fractions, and later a slightly harder tone was developed, but the changes in this direction were without significance.
