\$8,000,000 OF IROQUOIS DAMAGE SUITS KILLED

Chicago Decides City of Chicago Not Liable for Iroquois Theater Disaster.

CHICAGO, July 8.—Litigation to the probable aggregate total of \$8,000,000 has been discouraged by a ruling of Judge Holdom, in the superior court, to the effect that the city of Chicago was not liable in any degree for the Iroquois Theater fire.

A suit by Eva Catherine Gibson for \$15,000 damages, because of a broken arm and an injured spine, was the case decided.

Sixty other suits are pending, and had the decision been against the city, hundreds more probably would have been begun.

The opinion was on the city's demurrer to the averment that the theater was a public nuisance, and that the municipality was liable because of the dereliction of its officers in issuing a license before the theater had complied with the ordinances.

Even had the playhouse been a nuisance in the legal meaning of that word, the city, it was ruled, still would not have been liable.

Every trace of the word "Iroquois" on the theater building has been obliterated, and not even the sign remains to remind passersby of the accident in which more than 600 persons lost their lives.

Painters have covered up the words "Iroquois Theater" on the sign which extended along the Dearborn Street side of this building and painted over it "Vandeville Theater."

The Gothic letters of the name which appeared above the main entrance have been chiseled out.

RED ELECTRIC LIGHTS ONLY AT ALARM BOXES

Other Use Prohibited by the District in New Electric Regulations.

The use of red lights in signs and advertisements is to be stopped. The Electrical Department of the local government is of the opinion that as red electric lights are used to indicate fire alarm boxes, the indiscriminate use of red lights might lead to difficulty in locating alarm boxes in times of emergency.

Hereafter the man who has sought to call attention to his business by multi-colored electric bulbs, must cut out the red in the combination. This was decided on late yesterday afternoon, when District Commissioner Macfarland approved a set of electrical wiring regulations prepared by Engineer Allen.

In the future, according to these regulations, all pertaining to electric lighting and wiring in theaters and places of public assemblage will be under the supervision of the electrical engineer instead of the fire marshal.

Permits will have to be taken out for electric wiring or for altering the wiring in any building. All who wish to place electric lights outside of their premises must pay a fee of \$1. Electrical contractors will have to pay a license of \$5.

These regulations, however, will not be enforced until they have been declared legally correct by Corporation Counsel Duval.

TWO HORSES KILLED BY LIGHTNING BOLT

Public Wire Leading Into Office of Telegraph Buildings and Grounds Disturbed by Electricity.

Lightning struck and instantly killed two horses at Rhode Island and Lincoln Avenues northwest, belonging to Matthew Cook, living near Benning, yesterday afternoon.

The feed wire of the Lemon Building, in which Colonel Bromwell, Superintendent of Public Buildings and Grounds, has his office, was also struck. Only slight damage was done.

Mr. Cook was on his way home at the time the shower began. To shelter his horses he drove them under a tree, while he took refuge under a nearby shed.

Persons under the shed were almost blinded by the flash. There was also a terrific downpour of rain.
