NEW YORK, July 30.—Isaac W. Barnum, once a power in the financial world, lies dead in the meagerly furnished bed room in which he lived at 460 Franklin Avenue, Brooklyn, in his eightieth year this man, whose income was once \$5,000 a week from one of his investments in the hemming attachment to the sewing machine—peddled disinfectants to keep himself from starvation.
