ROCKVILLE NEWS ITEMS.

ROCKVILLE, Md., Jan. 28.—Aloysius Kelley, Walter Herold, Garnett Insko, and Floyd Insko, all white boys, aged from ten to fifteen years, are lodged in jail to await action upon a charge of assault with intent to kill Robert Watley, a deliveryman of a Washington firm. It appears that these boys live at Forest Glen, this county, where Watley had gone just previous to Christmas Day last to deliver some goods, and late in the evening at the electric car station at that place the above named boys had congregated. As the car came up Watley started to take the car, when the conductor pulled down the trolley pole from the wire, preparatory to leaving for Washington. When the light went out the crowd of boys attacked Watley. After the conductor had placed the trolley wheel in position, he saw what was going on and interfered. Watley was cut in several places, but not seriously. He had about \$17 on his person at the time. They were arrested and lodged in jail here on Thursday.
