

OLD CLERKS MUST QUIT, SAYS BILL IN CONGRESS

Mr. Garfield told in graphic language of the good results he had obtained from dismissing and demoting employees when there was the slightest complaint against their efficiency.

Will Enforce Law to Letter.

That the heads of departments will not be allowed to let the administration of the law be hampered by mercy and leniency is the general opinion at the Capitol today.

Such a provision has been put in the bill because the committee believes it will result in economy to the Government.

One argument used against the new provision is that it will add strength to the powers already wielded by petty chiefs of rooms and divisions.

It is finally voted into the bill, it is possible that an amendment will be offered to create a special board to determine the efficiency or superannuation of clerks.

A notable feature of the bill is that it raises the salaries of the high officials of the departments, bestowing on such persons as assistant secretaries of departments increases ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,000.

A new law is contained in the bill providing that hereafter no employe shall be transferred from one department to another until he or she shall have first served three years in the department from which he or she seeks transfer.

The bill was reported to the House by General Hingham, of Philadelphia, acting for the committee. It will be taken up in the House within the next few days.

Reduction of \$1,800,000.
The estimates on which the bill is based aggregate \$94,216,716.13, of which amount there is recommended in the bill \$22,235,716.13.

The appropriations for the same purposes for the current fiscal year, including \$750,000 in the sundry civil and deficiency acts of the last session, aggregated \$22,486,833.80, being \$3,250,833.80 more than is recommended in the accompanying bill for the service of the fiscal year 1908.
