

LEPER EARLY'S FATE HANGS IN BALANCE

Depends on Solicitor of Treasury's Opinion, Says Macfarland.

MAY NOT EVEN STAY CHARGE OF DISTRICT

Not Yet Decided Whether He Can Live With Wife and Child.

Commissioner Macfarland is not yet assured that John Early is to become a permanent charge upon the District. He said today that no definite plans have as yet been made for the permanent care of the leper and that none will be made until the Commissioner received the opinion of the Solicitor of the Treasury in the case.

If that opinion is adverse, he added he will ask Health Officer Woodward to submit to the Commissioners his official recommendation concerning what is to be done with Early.

It may be, he said, that he will be permitted to live with his wife and child or he may be isolated in a house in the country. Several tentative plans for his care are under consideration, but none have been appointed, nor will be, until it is an assured fact that Early is to remain in the District.

The question of the cost of Early's maintenance, and the proportionate amount to be borne by himself, will also be determined, the Commissioners say, after the receipt of the solicitor's opinion.

NO BATH IN 11 YEARS, WIFE GETS DIVORCE


Pittsburg Woman's Plea Convinces Court She Has Good Complaint.

JOSEPH M. BROWN, Georgia Democrat, Who Wins gubernatorial Race Over Independent Candidate.

INDEPENDENCE MAN BEATEN IN GEORGIA

Negroes Roll Up Large Majority for Democrat, and Disfranchise Themselves.

ATLANTA, Ga., Oct. 8.—Yancey Carter, candidate of the Independence party for governor of Georgia, was defeated today by Joseph M. Brown, Democrat, by a majority estimated from 40,000 to 50,000. The returns are incomplete, but they show that a very light vote was cast, probably 60 per cent of those registering going to the polls. The total of the State will hardly exceed 115,000 votes. Brown will probably get 58,000 and Carter 30,000.

A feature of the election was the manner in which negroes voted for Brown, the democratic nominee. The negroes had registered heavily to vote against the disfranchisement amendment, and they, as a rule, voted for Brown.

Brown has apparently received more negro votes than any Democrat who ever ran for governor of Georgia. The negro disfranchisement amendment, however, has been carried, although in a much smaller majority than Brown received.

PLANS EXTENDED FOR CLEAN CITY

Dr. Woodward Explains Need of Extra Force of Clean-up Men.

In asking for additional sanitary inspectors, Health Officer Dr. W. C. Woodward has in mind the continuation on a larger scale of the "campaign for cleanliness" in the District of Columbia.

Encouraged by the success of the crusade against the junkrooms, Dr. Woodward desires to extend the inspection service to lodging houses and to make more frequent house to house inspections in the alleys and slums.

"We were able to make only 4,204 house to house inspections in the alleys last year because of the lack of men," said Dr. Woodward today. "This is too small a percentage in a big city like Washington. In many houses there are three, four and five families quartered, living independently of one another and cooking, eating and sleeping in its own small rooms. These places must be removed and we must have more men to do it."

Dr. Woodward announced today that the Health Department will begin within a few days the enforcement of the law requiring the registration of stables.

"It is the desire of the department to give proprietors an opportunity to comply with the regulation after the notice is served, but the law in this regard will be strictly enforced," he said. "The penalty for failing to register is a \$25 fine."

RECORD OF CANNON SCORED BY GAINES

Tennessean Refers to the Speaker as Defender of Paper Trust.

Assailing Speaker Cannon, who he declared, "is the defender of the Paper trust and an obstructionist of sorely needed legislation," John Wesley Gaines of Tennessee, addressed a Democratic rally under the auspices of the Chevy Chase Democratic Club at Chevy Chase Lake last night.

Representative Gaines reviewed the Speaker's record, declaring him to be a representative of the trusts and Wall Street.

In this connection, he referred to the failure of the Republican Congress to pass measures for the relief of a people "suffering from the effects of Republican panic." As a cure for panics, Mr. Gaines advocated the adoption of Bryan's policy for the guarantee of bank deposits.

Andrew J. Cummings, a member of the Legislature of Maryland, presided. Addresses were made by Judge J. W. Nichol, Representative David Finley of Washington, and E. C. Peters, of Rockville. R. E. L. Yelott opened the meeting. A Bryan and Kern banner was erected near Bradley lane prior to the meeting.

REPUBLICAN COMMITTEE NAMED TO SEND THEM HOME FOR THE ELECTION.

For the purpose of urging voters in the District to return to their homes in the States to vote, Henry M. Camp, in charge of the local Republican headquarters as the representative of the Republican national committee, has announced the appointment of an active advisory committee.

It is composed of T. Lincoln Townsend, vice president of the National Electric Supply Company; John G. Capers, commissioner of Internal Revenue; Edgar C. Snyder, correspondent Omaha Bee; Thomas C. Noyes, The Evening Star; W. T. Vernon, Register of the Treasury; Sidney Bieber, member Republican national committee for the District; William S. Odell, president Taft and Sherman Club; H. H. Warner, real estate dealer; Andrew S. Burt, major general, U. S. A., retired; C. V. Gates, former president Sound Money League; Milo Shankus, treasurer League of Republican State Clubs; E. C. Graham, president National Electric Supply Company; Gus A. Schmidt, secretary of the League of Republican State Clubs, who will also act as secretary of the advisory committee; and J. K. White, of the United States Capitol, who has been named as assistant secretary.

DUNCAN LINES UP WITH HIS LEADER

Says Gompers and He Are in Union and Both Misquoted.

James Duncan, first vice president of the American Federation of Labor, has declared that he and President Gompers are in union on labor policies; that both have been misquoted, and reiterates that the Federation's attitude is not a partisan contention on the part of organized labor.

President Gompers has given out a telegram from Mr. Duncan sent to him for publication, in response to an inquiry concerning his attitude, which is in part as follows: "President Gompers and I are in union now, as we have been for many years, on the present, as well as other, principles and policies of the labor movement. I helped draft the recent program of the executive council of the American Federation of Labor, and support it now, as then, and my letter, to which you refer, was in accordance therewith, as well as in conformity to President Gompers' official statements on same subject."

HOMESEEKERS GIVE PLURALITY FOR TAFT

Local Republicans have been somewhat enthused by a telegram received by Henry M. Camp, in charge of the local headquarters, from Alexandria, S. D., giving the result of a straw vote taken on the Rosebud excursion out of Chicago.

The ballot stood 139 for Taft, 96 for Bryan, 13 for Debs, and 12 for Chaffin.
