

BURNELL SUCCEEDS IN AN ATTEMPT TO DRE

Death Comes to Army Officer Who Fired Bullet Into Brain.

FATHER EXPECTED TO ARRIVE TONIGHT

Physicians Were Planning to Trepan Skull as a Last Resort.

Capt. George C. Burnell, Signal Corps, U. S. A., who shot himself in the head in his room at the Laurel Sanitarium late Tuesday afternoon, died this morning at 7:30 o'clock.

The War Department has been notified of Captain Burnell's death, and everything is in readiness for burial in Arlington Cemetery, unless the father desires that interment be in Vermont.

The only motive known to Captain Burnell's friends in this city for his melancholy act is that he feared and suspected the approach of insanity. In this frame of mind he became moody, and life, which seemed to hold for him a bright prospect, ceased to be of interest.

"I fear that my mind is growing wrong and that madness is a short way off," he said, moodily, to Doctor Heller on Tuesday.

Shortly after Captain Burnell went to his room, ostensibly to gather up his few belongings, he was seen to be going to Washington with Dr. Heller, a series of loud thunders claps pealed forth.
