

LUTHERAN CIRCULAR
CAUSING COMMENT

Ultimatum Sent to "Secessionists" Not Given Official Notice.

ACTION IS POSSIBLE
LATE IN THE FALL

Some Wonderment Over Part of Phrasology—Olive Branch Is Waved.

Although the ultimatum which the council of the Lutheran Memorial Church has sent to individuals who left that church last February to found the Independent Lutheran Church, regarded by many members of the latter organization as just a little extraordinary in some of its phrasology, it is improbable that any congregational notice will be taken of it.

Certainly no action by all the seceding members will be taken before fall, and probably not then, although individuals may see fit to answer it at any time.

The ultimatum was signed by W. J. Sewalter, secretary of the council, and in every case is addressed to individuals whose names are filled in with ink. It recites the secession of the Independents, and says that since they have formed a church of their own and have refused to recognize the older church, they have forfeited all rights or privileges of the Lutheran Memorial Church, both under ecclesiastical and civil law.

Doors Are Open.

In the conclusion, the circular says that "if there be those who desire to return to the Memorial Church, the council will be glad to take that matter up with them individually," and assures every one that "each person appearing before the council will be given a private hearing." "There are those," says the circular, "who ought to return to the church, and they will find a spirit of conciliation should they return in like spirit."

The members of the Independent Congregation expressed surprise at this meeting at the terms used in this circular. The council of the Memorial Church in its acknowledgment that individuals have left its protection, and have formed a new church and also suggests that they return. This is not liked by the Independents, who regard it as an attempt to take away their members.

One of Reasons.

The circular states that one reason for its promulgation is the fact that the council of the Lutheran Church wishes to straighten out its record of membership, and to obtain a correct list. This list is necessary for presentation to the Maryland synod of the church in the fall.

While members of the Independent congregation have drawn up a tentative constitution, it is understood, that instrument will not be regarded or rejected until autumn, when many of the members now out of the city will have returned.

This tentative constitution, it is understood, will differ, especially in length, from that of the old church.

At present the council of the Memorial Church has no intention of erecting any church edifice. That may come later. The question of the calling of a pastor, too, will come later.

BOARD IS SUPPORTED
IN SANITARY FIGHT

No Complaints About Condemnation of Insanitary Buildings, Says Secretary Haynes.

That property owners and real estate men, instead of complaining of the work of the board for the condemnation of insanitary buildings, have co-operated with the board in the removal and repair of such structures, was the statement of Roy E. Haynes, secretary of the board today.

During the last fiscal year ended June 30, 231 buildings were removed by the board, and since its organization two years and a half ago 765 insanitary structures have been demolished. According to Secretary Haynes, there is at least two years' work ahead of the board before the city is rid of this class of buildings.

GAMBLING DEVICES
MAKE BIG BONFIRE

Paraphernalia of Taggart and Sinclair Casinos Finally Is Disposed Of.

PAOILLI, Ind., Aug. 13.—A pile of smoldering ashes with a few tarnished ornaments is all that remains today of gambling devices that cost \$200,000 when they were purchased by Tom Taggart and Lee Sinclair.

For three years this costly apparatus has been stored, awaiting the action of the court. About midnight last night the sheriff's men came to dispose of it as he deemed best, and with his deputies he attacked it with axes, piling the remains in a heap for a bonfire. Hundreds of people who had heard of the order of the court were present at the burning and applauded vigorously.

CABBIES SENTENCED
FOR CHEATING FARES

PARIS, Aug. 13.—Several Paris cabbies were today sentenced to various terms of imprisonment on conviction of having made their taxicabs register false distances.

Three of the convicted men had discovered a method by using a thread, to make the register run twice as fast as it should, and a fourth was caught turning the rear wheel of his "taxi" like a whirlwind. He had jacked up the cab for this purpose.

The frauds were in every case committed while the fares had temporarily left the cabs.

BIBLES ON TRAINS.


