President Will Address Children at Mass Meeting Tomorrow.

PUPILS MAY OWN BRICKS IN BUILDING

Active Campaign for Tribute to George Washington to Be Launched in District.

President Taft, Senators Lodge and Burton, and Mrs. Henry F. Dimock, of New York, president of the Washington Memorial Association, will be the speakers at the student mass meeting to be held tomorrow afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at Memorial Continental Hall.

With the enlistment of thousands of Washington young people in the patriotic ranks of the Memorial Association, Mrs. Dimock expects the association's work here to take on new life, and that Washington will no longer lag behind other cities in its contributions to the "George Washington Memorial Building."

In order that every child who attends the public schools of Washington may own a brick or several bricks in the building, these are now being prepared many thousand small buttons, each bearing a medallion head of Washington. These in gold will sell for 10 cents each, while the gold ones will cost \$1.00, and they will entitle their young wearers to own a brick or ten bricks in the building.

Arrangements are being made for a celebration of George Washington's Birthday at the Business High School, next Monday. Representative A. Mitchell Palmer, of the Twenty-sixth Pennsylvania district, will make an address on Washington's life. A splendid program of songs, recitations and declamations by the students has been arranged, and the celebration promises to be one of the most entertaining ever given by a Washington high school.
