DEATH CALL COMES TO JUDGE PORTLOCK

Virginia Jurist Dies After Long Illness—Funeral to Be Held Sunday.

NORFOLK, Va., June 17.—Former Judge William N. Portlock, for twenty years judge of the Norfolk county and later the circuit court, died today at his home at Portlock Station, not far from Berkeley. He had been ill for a long time, and

as a result had to resign from the bench. He was fifty-six years of age, and left an estate which includes valuable Norfolk city business property. He was succeeded on the bench by Judge Joseph T. Lawless. The funeral occurs Sunday at 4 p. m.
