

### FOOT PROVES FATAL TO STOWAWAY PLOT

#### New York Waiter Fails to Sail for That Dear France.

NEW YORK, Nov. 22.—Unless his next attempt to reach France as a stowaway is more successful than the one he made yesterday, Pierre Martin, a waiter of 70 Woodhull street, Brooklyn, will keep on lingering in that despised America. He was flung upon its cold shore—a pier, to be exact—by unsympathetic sailors of the Fabre line steamship Sant' Anna. Martin has been in this country only a short time, but it was long enough to make him wish himself back in Mar-

seilles. His total capital was \$10. He paid \$7 of the \$10 to two sailors to smuggle him on board the Sant' Anna. On the pier were several large linen baskets. Martin was placed in one of these, and the two sailors started for the gangplank, lugging the basket between them. The distance to travel was about two hundred yards, and soon Martin was on the verge of suffocation. The linen baskets are cloth-lined and almost air-tight. By the time the sailors had reached the gangplank Martin's struggle for air became so desperate that he kicked one foot through the basket. Captain Pavy, who was on deck, saw the shoe. Halting the sailors, he asked what such a thing was doing in a linen basket. They dropped the load, but said nothing. At the command of Captain Pavy other sailors removed the cover, revealing Martin. The two basket carriers were ordered below, and Martin was hustled ashore, minus \$7, and as far from Marcellas as ever.

### AWAIT ORDERS TO SHIP BODY

RICHMOND, Va., Nov. 22.—The body of Dr. John W. Cringan, a physician of Nelson county, is at present in this city awaiting shipment to his former home. Dr. Cringan died suddenly on board a Chesapeake and Ohio train yesterday.

### DEATH IS SUDDEN FOR B. F. DILLON, SR.

#### Western Union Official Was Ill Only Fifteen Minutes.

ATLANTA, Ga., Nov. 22.—Benjamin F. Dillon, sr., general superintendent of the Southern division of the Western Union Telegraph Company, died suddenly at his home at midnight. Death was caused by acute indigestion followed by a stroke of apoplexy. He was not ill over fifteen minutes. Mr. Dillon was sixty-two years old and came here about a year ago from Jacksonville, Fla., where his body will be taken for burial today.

### HOSPITAL ROMANCE ENDS IN WEDDING

#### Political Leader McNichol Marries Nurse He Met by Chance.

BOSTON, Nov. 22.—A chance meeting in a hospital, in which she was a nurse, resulted in the marriage today at St. Mary's of the Assumption Church, Brookline, of Miss Margaret Donohue, of that town, and State Senator J. P. McNichol, of Philadelphia, a Republican leader, subway builder, and millionaire. Miss Donohue is about thirty-five, and was formerly head nurse of the Philadelphia General Hospital, but she resigned some months ago, and went abroad. Miss Donohue came originally from the Massachusetts General Hospital. Senator McNichol is a widower with ten children. His wife died a year and a half ago. The couple left for Florida, where they will spend the honeymoon.
