MEATS ARE STOLEN FROM FREIGHT CAR

Robbery on Alexandria Siding Only One of Many in Recent Months—Many Detectives and Police Are Working to End Thefts.

WASHINGTON TIMES BUREAU, ALEXANDRIA, VA., JAN. 2. Report was made to the Alexandria police department this morning of the robbery of one of the refrigerator cars of Swift & Co., meat packers, while it was standing on the tracks on Union street, between Prince and Duke streets.

According to the report of City Sergeant Robert H. Cox, 361 prisoners were lodged at the city jail in the last year. Of these, 116 were white men and 145 colored. Eight white women and sixty-six colored were locked up.

COURT OF APPEALS DECISION TO BRING HALSTEAD TO TRIAL

Ruling Quashing Indictment on Embezzlement Charge Reversed.

Griffin Halstead, a former stock broker and son of the late Murat Halstead, of Ohio, will probably have to stand trial in the District Criminal Court on charges of embezzlement and obtaining money under false pretenses, the District Court of Appeals having reversed the lower court's decision quashing the indictment, in an opinion handed down today.
