Dr. Shaw Denies She Gave Views on Marriage

That the published interview giving what were alleged to be her views on marriage was absolutely false and misleading, is asserted by Dr. Anna Howard Shaw, president of the National American Woman's Suffrage Association, in a statement just issued.

The report had a portion of my interview," says Dr. Shaw, "but added to that was a garbled mass of statements upon marriage, not a word of which had been given to the reporter. In fact, I did not discuss the subject of marriage with the reporter at all. There were statements made which are so contrary to my own views that they could not have been formed on any honest interpretation of anything I have ever said on the subject. So false and misleading was this report that it has led to various almost libelous editorials and criticisms from all parts of the country.


