

ARCHITECTS OF U.S. OFFER DISTRICT AID

Institute Proposes Commission to Deal With Housing and City Planning.

Resolutions pledging the American Institute of Architects to give active cooperation in bettering housing conditions among those of limited means in the United States and to bring cooperation in the development of the National Capital, have been transmitted to President Wilson.

The American Institute of Architects is the national organization of architects in the United States, with chapters in nearly every State.

Resolutions Adopted. The two resolutions, which were adopted by the board of directors of the institute and transmitted to the President, are as follows:

Resolved, that the board of directors of the American Institute of Architects request the committee on town planning to urge through its subcommittees in every locality, that the architects of this country devote their attention to the improvement of the design and arrangement of the small and medium sized houses in all cities and suburbs, and to bring about, as far as possible, an improvement in existing conditions.

Resolved, that with reference specifically to the city of Washington, the board, with a high sense of appreciation for what has been done toward preserving the original L'Enfant plan, offer to cooperate with the officials in charge of the development of the National Capital, hereby offering to appoint a committee on the plan of Washington, and to advise the officials of the institute, to be known as the "Committee on the Plan of Washington," and to advise the officials of the institute, to be known as the "Committee on the Plan of Washington."

In a statement accompanying announcement of the adoption of the resolution, it is declared that the offer to appoint a committee on the plan of Washington is one that should be of interest, not only to every citizen of the District, but to every citizen of the United States.
