Monster Parade of Suffragists Today Brings Visible Appeal To New York Male Electorate

Empire State Leaders Swing Into Line In Notable Demonstration With Floats and Tableaux.

THE last massed appeal of the women of New York to the male voters who are to pass upon the suffrage question on November 2 is being made today, when 50,000 suffragists march in a monster parade through the streets of New York.

Undaunted by the defeat in New Jersey, and desirous of concentrating every effort in an attempt to impress the importance of the question upon the male mind in New York, every possible means of putting the arguments before the public employed.

Features of Suffrage Parade Today

Suffragists announce there will be 50,000 women. Brooklyn expects to turn out, 12,000 strong. Time of start—2 o'clock, Saturday, October 23. Route of march—Up Fifth avenue, from Washington square to Fifty-ninth street.


