GREECE OPENS ALL HARBORS TO ALLIES' USE

Agrees to Free Use of Macedonian Railways, Says Berlin Report.

TO INTERN NO REFUGEES

Serbian Cross Border to Reorganize Before Joining Anglo-French Force.

COPENHAGEN, Dec. 4.—Greece has agreed to give the allies the free use of all railways in Macedonia and all Aegean harbors, including that of Kavalla, according to the Berliner Tageblatt.

Greeks Allow Serbs To Cross Border to Escape Bulgarians

ATHENS, Dec. 4.—Part of the Serbian army of General Vassich, retiring from the region of Monastir, has crossed the frontier and taken refuge in Greece.

Few Prisoners Taken.


