

EPISCOPAL SCHOOL IS READY TO OPEN

Theological Seminary at Alexandria Has an Enrollment of Forty-two Students.

ALEXANDRIA, Sept. 19.—Tomorrow will mark the opening of the Episcopal Theological Seminary.

Forty-two students are enrolled, of which twenty-one will come the junior class. The Rev. Dr. Berryman Green will occupy the position of dean, succeeding the Rev. Angus Crawford, who remains a member of the faculty. The Rev. G. Freeland Peter, rector of St. James Church, of Richmond, will preach at the seminary chapel services next Sunday morning.

Miss Mary V. Douglas, of Aldie, was elected a teacher last night by the city school board, in place of Miss Rubie L. Broadus, who recently resigned.

DIVORCE LAWS LAX, DECLARES JURIST

Says Young People Fail to Give Proper Thought to Responsibility of Marriage.

OAKLAND, Cal., Sept. 19.—Couples plunging into the marriage sea without the proper realization of the enormous responsibilities they have taken upon themselves; without due deference to the advice of older persons whose ideas on life are far more matured than the younger persons, and with a careless disregard for the future, financially or otherwise, are condemned by Superior Judge William H. Donahue.

"The trouble with young couples of today," said Donahue, "is that they do not appreciate the obligation of the marriage tie toward one another, nor do they ever let the tremendous responsibility they assume when they bring children into the world litter across their minds.

Parents have duties to perform toward their offspring just as children have duties to perform toward their parents. Many cases come before me where the couple's plea for wishing the marriage tie dissolved is incompatibility. In nine cases out of ten such couples are the parents of small children who, naturally, are deprived of the home influences and training when the divorce is granted.

"Incompatibility is generally the stereotyped plea of those persons who do not really understand the workings of their own mind. Prior to their marriage couples should understand one another thoroughly to decide the possibility of their pre-nuptial dreams being shattered. If time was allowed by the lovers for such a slow but sure process of understanding, I am certain there would be fewer applications for divorce.

Hearings on applications for liquor licenses probably will be begun by the Excise Board October 9. It is expected the hearings will occupy two weeks. The unopposed cases, it is understood, will be the first to be considered. The board will conclude its inspection of bars and wholesale establishments this week.

MAJ. D. S. FLETCHER HEADS CITIZEN BODY

Officers Elected for Year by Takoma Park Association at Initial Meeting.

Major D. S. Fletcher was elected president of the Takoma Park Citizens' Association at the first meeting of the year last night.

Other officers named were: Prof. H. C. Gore, vice president; C. C. King, secretary (re-elected); William Stuart, assistant secretary (re-elected); J. B. Kiefer, treasurer (re-elected); Dr. D. N. Shoemaker, delegate to the Federation of Citizens' Associations (re-elected); and C. A. Reed, alternate. Mrs. H. C. Gore and Mrs. C. A. Reed were elected to membership in the association, which some time ago amended its constitution to admit women. Protests were made by the association against the ordinance recently passed by the Takoma Park, Md., town council prohibiting coasting in "skimpobles" or other "wheeled vehicles with metal

tires" on the streets of the Maryland municipality. The mayor and council will be requested to amend the ordinance. The motion protesting was made by Vice President Gore.

An eight-room addition to the Takoma Park School was requested by the committee on education of the association

at a hearing before the Board of Education yesterday afternoon.




