

FATHER RUSSELL TO RECEIVE TRIBUTE

Senator Ransdell Will Speak At Public Farewell to Bishop-Elect.

Senator Ransdell of Louisiana will be one of the chief speakers at the public testimonial to be given to the late Bishop-elect William T. Russell, in Polk's theater, at 3 o'clock, next Sunday afternoon.

Other speakers will be John Barrett, director of the Pan-American Union; Dr. Hannis Taylor, and Bishop Shehan, of Catholic University.

Judge Martin A. Knapp, chairman of the United States board of mediation and conciliation, will preside.

After addresses by prominent Washington citizens, in appreciation of the esteem in which Bishop-elect Russell is held here, opportunity will be given the audience to say "good-by" to Bishop-elect Russell before he leaves that night for his see in Charleston, S. C.

Open To Public. The doors of the theater will be opened at 2:30 o'clock. There will be no cards of admission except to the stage and boxes.

The committee on arrangements for the testimonial include prominent citizens from every walk of life in the city.

Preparations are going on for the consecration of Bishop-elect Russell in Baltimore on Thursday. Many members of the Protestant clergy from here will attend.

The Washington delegation to Baltimore includes the Rev. John E. Van Schaick, Jr., president of the Board of Education; Rabbi Abram Simon, Dr. J. Henning Nelms, and many others.

Among those who made reservation to attend the consecration and leave Washington on the special train on Thursday are Senator Saulsbury and Mrs. Saulsbury.

From Charleston a delegation of clergy and citizens will be headed by J. R. Rafferty, state deputy of the Knights of Columbus.

The installation of Bishop-elect Russell on March 22 at Charleston, will be attended by many Washington and Baltimore friends of the Catholic faith.

Governor of California Brands Resignation Story As False. SACRAMENTO, Cal., March 11.—Gov. Hiram Johnson branded as "absolutely and unqualifiedly false" a story circulated throughout the country by some newspapers that he would announce tomorrow his resignation from the United States Senate, rather than leave the governorship of California at this time.

In response to a telegram from a New York newspaper he has issued the following statement: "This is just another fake of Harrison Gray Otis and the Los Angeles Times, like the other stories of the Times and of Otis. It is wholly and absolutely false. The story emanated from Otis's correspondent in Sacramento, who concedes that his employment is to manufacture any sort of tale and disseminate it in the East."

GERMANY ON VERGE OF FINANCIAL RUIN

Starvation Threatens As Fiscal System Staggers Under War's Burdens. Germany's financial system is staggering to the point of collapse.

This, coupled with a growing shortage of food that pinches more and more, is gradually squeezing out the endurance of the German nation and bringing the end of the war nearer.

These facts are revealed by information in possession of this Government today.

This information, tending to verify the meager news of approaching starvation coming out of Germany, stresses the financial side more than the food situation.

Germany practically is "kiting" checks. She is draining the gold of the whole nation, and must make one loan stand as payment for another.

Information today indicates that a state approaching national bankruptcy will result if the war goes on much longer.

The food situation is pictured as extremely depressing. A striking evidence of how short of food Germany really is lies in the fact that American Yarrowdale prisoners were kept on rations that stripped the flesh from their bones.

Many Germans are ill-nourished, and her fighting men, though still well supplied, are not getting full rations of such foods as fighters require for keeping their "staying power."

Furthermore, Germany is conducting an apparently deliberate campaign of misinformation. First, that she is misinforming her people about her ability to get news from the outside world, particularly the United States. As a matter of fact, she can get in most complete detail through wireless channels.

In the second place, it has developed that the Berliner Tageblatt March 11 declared German prisoners in Russia were better treated, "due to the attention of the Swedish and Danish Red Cross, who have taken over German interests in Russia since the break" with the United States. The American Red Cross is still in charge of the prison work.

REBUILDS AVIATION SCHOOL Government Reconstructing Plant of Philadelphia Institution. PHILADELPHIA, March 11.—The Philadelphia school of aviation at Eastington, recently taken over by the United States Government as a training school for civilian aviators, today is under process of reconstruction looking to better equipment. New apparatus of all kinds is being installed.

Buildings for additional hydro-aeroplanes and engine shops will be rushed as rapidly as possible, it was announced.
