

MARRYING SLACKER RAPPED BY SUNDAY

Man Who Hides Behind Skirt Coward, Says Evangelist. Cost of Saving Souls.

NEW YORK, April 13.—Twenty years of whipping the devil over the forty-eight States have persuaded Billy Sunday that the old fellow doesn't hold his grip very well south of Mason and Dixon's line, the Ohio river, and the Moonshine mountains. It's here in the North that the original enemy of the human race gets in his best lines.

Billy has the figures that prove it—soul saving cost estimates gathered from a score of cities. Would one think now that the capital of Hoosierdom is the devil's choicest earthly lair, except for New York, where it takes \$800 to win a man from sin and set him in the straight and narrow road. This estimate is only a rough one, however. Billy's three months' campaign here will cost \$150,000, and the new soul saving cost sheets will be prepared through a process of dividing the \$150,000 by the number of souls that respond to Billy's fervent pleas.

He is in New York for the big and principal purpose of showing the preachers what real soul saving efficiency is, and he expects to cut the old figures to shinders and raise New York to the proud position occupied by Louisville or Atlanta, where the cost is \$80; or New Orleans, where it takes \$100, and to beat Chicago's \$448, Boston's \$500, and Denver's \$455. More than 17,000 men and women listened to Billy in the tabernacle at Broadway and 168th street with approval and keen delight last night—heard him deliver the spiciest gospel talk that so far has been heard. He beat the Old One up and down the platform, whacking manfully. The metaphor is not strained. When he talks of pursuing and chastising Satan he pursues and chastises, literally. He grips an imaginary whip, crouches like a tiger, sets his jaws, whistles his breath through his teeth, screams a defiance, hurls himself across the platform, and when he raises his voice in shouts of hallelujah, strikes downward with slashing strokes, ripping the hide off a Satan that one can almost see, so strongly has Billy the power of visualizing his parables.

D. C. JUSTICES JOIN IN MILITARY DRILLS

Court Attaches, Officials, and Attorneys Participate in Initial Exercises.

They are turning square corners, saluting their superiors and walking with increased military "pep" today at the City Hall, as a result of the preparedness drills inaugurated there late yesterday afternoon by Prof. Maurice Joyce and aides. The unoccupied portion of the building at First and B streets northwest has been converted into a huge gymnasium, and hereafter three times a week justices, court attaches, lawyers and all who desire to become better physically fit will be sent through the paces by the instructor. The next drill will be held Monday afternoon at 4 o'clock.

Approved by Justices. The scheme was originated by William F. Lemon, assistant clerk of the court, and Prof. Joyce, who desired to "do their bit" by equipping men who may enter the army or naval service of the country with the physical attainments necessary to expedite their acceptance. The move, which is a purely patriotic one, was heartily approved by the justices of the court. Henry V. Cox, in behalf of the heirs of the Emery estate, cheerfully donated the use of the building for the drills.

WILSON AND M'ADOO TO BE BIG LENDERS

Will Have Unrestricted Power to Furnish Three Billions To Allies.

When Congress passes the bond issue bill, President Wilson and Secretary McAdoo will rank among the greatest money lenders of all time. Under the liberal authorization of the bill they are given unrestricted power to loan \$3,000,000,000 to foreign governments. J. P. Morgan & Co., through numerous private investment firms, floated a loan to the allies of approximately a billion dollars, but the one contemplated by President Wilson and Secretary McAdoo is already three times that amount, and before the war is over may reach an even greater figure.
