LONDON, July 22.—Against Germany's claims of nearly a million tons of shipping sunk each month since unbridled submarine warfare was proclaimed, England today contrasted Premier Lloyd George's confident statement of yesterday afternoon: "Gradually but surely we are increasing our protection and diminishing our losses."
