

2,000 CONVERTS IS ONE NIGHT'S GRIST FOR SUNDAY'S MILL

ATLANTA, Ga., Dec. 12.—The greatest feat of his revival in Atlanta was performed by Billy Sunday last night, when 2,000 converts marched down the sawdust trail in the tabernacle and shook hands with the great evangelist, declaring their intention of leading a straight and honorable life according to the mandates of Christianity.

It was Shiner night, and the red-frenzied, gayly uniformed Masons, 600 strong, invaded the tabernacle like a wave of gray pigments flooding a sun-bronzed shore and split into bright little wavelets of color here and there in the great audience like particles of surf glittering in the sunshine of a summer day.

Billy preached one of the strongest sermons of his career. He attacked the sins of the city; declared against the productions now disgracing the boards of the theater, and spoke in unmistakable language of the extravagance of the "society" matrons of the wealthy centers of the country. Not against the theater, but against the ends to which the theater has been brought by the popular clamor for that which is vile and vicious. The theater, declared the evangelist, had its origin in the religious forum. It is only the desire of the people that influence the theatrical managers to produce the "leg" show and the "sex" drama. It is the answer to popular demand. So the blame lies entirely with the people. "It is what they want," he declared.

In anticipation of his campaign in Washington, Billy told newspaper men that he expected one of the greatest revivals of his career in the National Capital. He will leave Atlanta December 23 and will arrive in Washington January 6.

TRINITY FUND WORKERS CELEBRATE SUCCESS

In celebration of their having collected more than \$90,000 where they had set out to get \$75,000 in a ten-day drive, several hundred workers of Holy Trinity parish, Georgetown, stayed up nearly all night to make merry over the achievement.

There was a carnival, following a banquet in the parish hall on N street near Thirty-sixth street, which did not break up until after 4 o'clock this morning.

The complete returns registered on the big speedometer in front of the church today show \$90,226.51 collected for the school building fund. There had been \$65,000 previously contributed, so that more than \$150,000 is now ready to pay for the group of schools and parish hall now being erected. The men's teams brought in \$4,637 yesterday while the women's teams brought in \$4,324.25, making a total for the closing day of \$9,023.23.

TRUST COMPANY CITED IN CROSBY HOTEL CASE

The Maryland Mining and Trust Company has been cited by Justice Siddons to show cause on Friday why rents of the Crosby Hotel, Third and C street northwest, should not be paid to a receiver pending settlement of a suit filed by George S. Ziller and his wife, Mrs. Della G. Ziller, who asked that the company be compelled to carry out a contract of exchange of real estate.

The suit alleges that the Maryland company undertook to convey to the plaintiffs the Crosby Hotel property for a farm known as the Burgundy, in Fairfax county, Va., of 270 acres and valued at \$50,000, and that instead of carrying out the terms of the exchange, the Maryland company sold into a lease for the hotel property for a large rental made possible by the great influx of people into the city.






