

3,001 TONS OF COAL REACHED C. WITHIN 24 HOURS

Three thousand one tons of anthracite coal was received in Washington in the twenty-four hours ending at 7 a. m. today, according to reports to Federal Fuel Administrator John L. Weaver.

Receipts are already reflecting the orders of Dr. Garfield for 2,400 tons of anthracite a day to meet the requirements of Washington householders. It is hoped and expected that they will continue at the same rate. Shipments from the mines among which the Washington orders were distributed have been moving for the past three or four days, and they will begin reaching Washington by mid-week. The anthracite now coming in is coal that was on the railroads, which have been cleared, and cars diverted to Washington from other points.

An easing off of emergency demands from householders is expected within a few days, new by Mr. Weaver and his assistants. The emergency business in Thirteenth and F streets will not be closed, however, until there is no longer necessity for it, and the dealers are still without a supply, and until they get coal to meet orders, emergency distribution will be kept up.

Preparing coal among the dealers will begin under plans drawn by Mr. Weaver and C. F. Fodeley, chairman of the coal merchants' executive committee, as soon as the direct orders from the mines come in.

Coal reaching Washington at present is on direct consignment to the dealer, and it will keep the emergency bureau supplied, until the dealers are able to keep up with the demand.

CONFERENCE TO DEMAND WAR FINANCE CHANGES

John Sparzo, who recently left the Socialist party, will arrive here today to address a conference tomorrow, at the National Hotel, of the Association for an Equitable Federal Income Tax. The object of the conference is to discuss democratic financing of the war.

The conference has been called at the request of labor and farm organizations to demand that the war revenue bill be repealed, and that the wealthy class and beneficiaries of war expenditures be compelled to pay what the conferees style a "fair part of the cost of the war."

Chairman Kilburn of the House Ways and Means Committee, and Chairman Simmons, of the Senate Finance Committee, have arranged to see a delegation from the conference.

Other speakers will be Frank P. Walsh, chairman of the Committee on Industrial Relations; John J. Hopper, president of the association; J. J. Coughlin, president of the Central Labor Union of Brooklyn; David Coates, manager of the National Party for the middle West; Western Starr, president of the Farmers' Single Tax League; Chester M. Wri st, manager, Alliance for Democracy and Labor; Benjamin C. Marsh, executive secretary of the association, and others.
