

**SPANISH MAIDENS
IN "LAND OF JOY"
STAR AT NATIONAL**

With the click of countless cha-
trnets "The Land of Joy" was usher-
ed into the Capital at the National
last night and hundreds of first-night-
ers went home delighted.
This Spanish-American revue is
something new, with enough catchy
tunes to furnish a half dozen ordi-
nary musical comedies and a number
of Spanish chorus girls any one of
whom would be a star in a produc-
tion made in this country.
"The Land of Joy" is an entertain-
ment midway between a French revue
and an opera comique with no trace
of a plot, but plenty of dances and
songs. And the dances are graceful,
seductive, skillful and artistic. These
Spanish choristas have the technique
of the hip and the knee-cap, not to
mention the heel, down to perfection
and they are rhythmic and undulat-
ing.

Spain's Waltz King.
Quinto Valverde, the composer, is
called the "waltz king" of Spain. A
great deal of the music is syncopated,
but these dancers for whom life
seems to be just one fling after
another do it as a matter of course.

Dolores is the premier dancer, but
then there is Violeta and Manzan-
tina and about a dozen others who
are past mistresses of the terpsichor-
ean art. Bibbo is the only male
dancer, and he is a revelation.

As for the singers, Maria Marco,
Ampora Sans and Luisita Puchol
stand out as the prima donnas, and
they add to the general joy of the
performance. "Ay que Rico," which
Julius Tannen, the only American in
the company, translated as meaning
"Oh how lovely," won several encores
and Senorita Puchol deserved the ap-
plause as well as the dashing Span-
ish chorus.

Mr. Tannen acts as interpreter of
the various scenes which lead the
audience from Valencia, to Granada,
the Alhambra, the fair at Seville, a
bull ring, and finally to Madrid,
where the finale is staged with a
dancing contest which roused the first
nighters to enthusiasm, the hand-
clapping vying with the castanets of
the chorus, which also grows genu-
inely excited as their favorites re-
spond to an abandonment of happi-
ness.

It would take more than a column
to describe the wondrous gowns,
shawls, mantillas, and combs worn by
the choristas. During its twenty
weeks' run in New York "The Land
of Joy" became a society fad because
of these costumes.

Dancing is Refreshing.
To a public fed up on Russian bal-
lets, Hawaiian wiggles, and classic
dances of beautifully clad Grecian ma-
idens, the dancing in this new produc-
tion is refreshing.

The scenery also is new to Ameri-
can theatergoers, and several of the
settings drew applause while the
stage was empty awaiting the prin-
cipals.

Just before the close Senora Marco
and Manuel Villa, the celebrated bar-
itone of the Royal Opera, Madrid, and
a favorite in Paris before the war,
sang a duet entitled "Penamiente
Encarnado." It dealt with love,
and Mr. Tannen a few
moments later explained that much of
the success of the number was due to
the fact that the singers were man
and wife.
"The Land of Joy" seems due to
register as big a hit in Washington
as it did in New York.
