

WAR LOAN POSTERS OUT TOMORROW

Washingtonians will view tomorrow for the first time the colored posters, stickers, and stickers. Advertising the Liberty Loan, several million copies of which have been furnished the District Liberty Loan committee, by the Treasury.

The work of putting up the posters will begin early tomorrow morning, under the supervision of J. S. J. Clark, chairman of the subcommittee on posters.

The department stores will have special displays in their windows featuring the posters, while the windows of business houses generally will be decorated with the posters.

By beginning to distribute the posters tomorrow, the Liberty Loan committee expects to have the work completed by Friday night, so that the campaign opens Saturday.
