WANT CHILDREN TO KICK GERMAN TOYS

NEW YORK, Nov. 2.—Fifty indignant men and women, wrathful over the fact that most of the German toys which bought these children yesterday during the last fortnight have been taken from the ship by various firms which bought them, gathered yesterday at a meeting at the American Relief Legion, 5 Fifth avenue, to picket all shops near they may be offered for sale.

If the pickets can't prevent the sale of all the German toys a "national destruction day" will be proclaimed by Mrs. Oliver Cromwell Field, president of the A. R. L. Charles R. Steals, 300 Fifth avenue, offered the resolution embodying this plan.

Another man put through a resolution which he said covered the crisis more completely. "Declare a national expression day," he said, "and on that day let all patriotic citizens throw out into the streets everything that is German made, their steins, their Goethes, their German toys, and not only everything that comes from Germany but everything that comes from neutral countries."
